MNU ADMISSIONS PROCESS FOR INTERNATIONAL TRANSFER STUDENTS

- STEP 1** Official INTERNATIONAL STUDENT APPLICATION submitted to the MNU International Student Advisor 30 days prior to the beginning of the semester, along with copies of a current I-20, visa, passport, I-94, and other relevant INS documents.
- STEP 2** Payment of the following university fees must accompany your application:
- A **\$25.00** nonrefundable application fee.
 - A **\$100.00** refundable room deposit fee. (International Students who are 22 years of age or older may elect to live off-campus. Other International Students may petition to live off-campus with a sponsor or with members of their family who may reside in the area. **International students who do not meet these requirements must live in campus housing.**)
 - A **\$15,000.00** refundable pre-registration fee as a "down payment" on your tuition and other costs, which will be credited to an account established in your name.
- PLEASE NOTE: REQUIRED ADMISSION FEES MUST BE PAID IN U. S. DOLLARS BY EITHER A PERSONAL BANK CHECK OR BANK DRAFT/MONEY ORDER.**
- STEP 3** All **OFFICIAL** transcripts of completed college and university work sent directly to the MNU International Student Office. Transfer credit for coursework completed at institutions outside of the United States may be considered, upon receipt of an official evaluation document sent from an appropriate credential evaluation organization. Only official documents are acceptable: photocopies will not be accepted.
- STEP 4** Section I of the STATUS FORM FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENT TRANSFER FROM A UNITED STATES COLLEGE OR UNIVERSITY completed by the International Student applicant. Section II completed by the International Student Officer (ISO) of the college or university of the student's present attendance or most recent attendance, and sent directly to the MNU International Student Office.
- STEP 5** An **OFFICIAL TOEFL** score (paper-based / minimum of **500**, computer-based / minimum of **173**) sent directly to the MNU International Student Office. (MNU's TOEFL Code Number is **6437**.) In lieu of the TOEFL requirement, International Students whose first language is English must request that an official ACT and/or SAT, score which meets general admissions standards, be sent. (MNU's ACT Code Number is **1445**; the SAT Code Number is **6437**). (Consideration for waiving the TOEFL requirement is a possibility for the International Student transferring from a United States English-speaking institution.)
- STEP 6** The INTERNATIONAL STUDENT FINANCIAL SUMMARY, completed, signed, and returned.
- STEP 7** The original, notarized AFFIDAVIT OF SUPPORT sent by the student's sponsor, along with SUPPORTING EVIDENCE, as specified in Part II of the instructions.
- STEP 8** The INTERNATIONAL STUDENT HEALTH HISTORY, completed and returned. **All immunizations must be documented by the student's physician and/or health official.**
- STEP 9** "Applicant" portion of the APPLICATION REFERENCE completed. "Reference" portion completed by the Reference Person selected (not a relative) and returned directly to MNU, via the addressed envelope.

ALL NINE STEPS MUST BE COMPLETED BEFORE ADMISSION IS GRANTED AND AN I-20 ISSUED FOR STUDY AT MIDAMERICA NAZARENE UNIVERSITY.
