Information About the Camps

Costs:

General Skills Camp I (3-6 grade boys/girls) - \$140.00

This camp covers all individual volleyball skills for the beginning player. There is a limit of 30 campers per session.

General Skills Camp II (7-12 grade) - \$195.00

This camp covers all individual volleyball skills to improve a player's overall skill. There is a limit of 80 campers per camp session.

Elite Camp (10-12 grade) - \$120.00

This camp is for the varsity-level/advanced player wanting to learn the skills to compete as a future college volleyball player. There is a limit of 40 campers.
