2018 Exit Survey Results

Key Findings

G1 – Ethics - 100% of students agree/strongly agree that they were prepared to demonstrate ethical business conduct.

G2 – Communication – 95% of students agree/strongly agree that they were prepared to effectively communicate in business.

G3 – Critical Thinking – 89.5% of students agree/strongly agree that they were prepared to demonstrate critical thinking skills.

G4 – Technology – 68% of students agree/strongly agree that they were prepared to use technology in business.

G5 – Management/Leadership – 95% of students agree/strongly agree that they were prepared to understand management and leadership theories and best practices.

G6 – Career Preparation – 89.5% of students agree/strongly agree that the curriculum prepared them for their future career.

Overall Evaluations

95% of students are satisfied/very satisfied with the instruction received in business program.

97% of students agree/strongly agree that the curriculum was applicable for today's business issues.

79% of students were satisfied/very satisfied with the coursework in the program.

95% of students were satisfied/very satisfied with the overall business program.

89.5% of students agree/strongly agree that they would recommend MNU's business program to a friend.

95% of students agree/strongly agree that MNU's business program prepared them with the knowledge and skills to enter a career in business and/or pursue graduate school or professional certification.

47% of students had a full-time job or job offer in the field of business, prior to graduation.

5% of students were already enrolled in graduate school, prior to graduation.

2018 Alumni Survey Highlights

Key Findings

75% of one-year business alumni are currently employed in a business-related field.
(100% of those students were offered the job within 3 months of graduating.)

Specifically:

67% received their first career-track job offer at or before graduation.

33% received their first career-track job offer 1-3 months after graduation.

25% of one-year business alumni are currently enrolled in graduate school.

In reflecting back on the program, the following percentages of alumni students stated they were satisfied or very satisfied about the following aspects of the program:

100% – business faculty

100% – business curriculum

25%– course scheduling

75%– academic advising

100%– emphasis on Christian ethics

The following percentages of alumni students rated the level of preparation received from MNU's business program for the following areas as above average or excellent:

100% – leadership skills

100% – job interviewing skills

75%– oral presentation skills

100% – written communication skills

75% – problem solving and decision-making skills

100% – organizational communication skills

75%– technology skills

100%– teamwork skills

75% of MNU business alumni agree/strongly agree that their academic experiences in the MNU business department prepared them for the next steps in their professional future.

75% of MNU business alumni agree/strongly agree that they would recommend this program to others wishing to pursue business careers.
