Key Findings

60% of one-year business alumni who responded to the survey are currently employed in a business-related field.

20% of one-year business alumni who responded to the survey are currently enrolled in graduate school.

In reflecting back on the program, the following percentages of alumni students who responded to the survey stated they were satisfied or very satisfied about the following aspects of the program:

- 100% – business faculty
- 100% – business curriculum
- 100% – course scheduling
- 100% – emphasis on Christian ethics

The following percentages of alumni students who responded to the survey rated the level of preparation received from MNU's business program for the following areas as above average or excellent:

- 100% – leadership skills
- 100% – organizational communication skills
- 100% – teamwork skills

100% of MNU business alumni who responded to the survey stated some level of agreement that their academic experiences in the MNU business department prepared them for the next steps in their professional future.

100% of MNU business alumni who responded to the survey stated some level of agreement that they would recommend this program to others wishing to pursue business careers.
